Present job of Organization

The Organization is currently working on the following Themes.

Theme- Disability

PRERAK directly Working with 100 children with special needs, Under the project 'CWSN' in Churra block of in 169 villages. The Main focus area of Prerak organization is Children with disabilities in which we seek to assist them in Equal Opportunity for Education, Equal respect in the society and to make them aware of the government schemes. These children have different types of disabilities like Cerebral Palsy, Mental illness, Multiple Disability, Mentally Retired, Orthopedic and visually Impaired. According to their need and requirement, all they are receiving various services like physical exercises, physiotherapy services, daily living skills, supportive education, techniques on mobility for visually impaired and orthopedic children in their door step. Apart from that a residential School for 100 children with disabilities is running by the Prerak at Rajim. Along with that our special educators facilitates the students by home visit that are in their homes in the period of lockdown. According to their need and requirement, all they are receiving various services like physical exercises, physiotherapy services, daily living skills, supportive education, techniques on mobility for visually impaired and orthopedic children in their door. The special physiotherapy services are provided by the special educators of Prerak organization through home visit.

Theme-Tribal Rights, forest land recognition

Under PESL project the organization focuses of the Forest Rights Act which includes Community Forest Rights and individual Forest Rights for the Forest dwellers and other Traditional Forest dwellers in 320 villages of 10 districts of Chhattisgarh. The organization is fighting for the rights of forest dwelling communities. Total number of 56 claims of CFR has been awarded for the year 2020. People of these communities are being aware for their Forest rights. Along with that the organization is helping in accessing their rights by the medium of Community Forest Rights, Individual Forest Rights, and Habitat Rights. With that the organization is also trying to provide fair price and market for the NTFP collections done by the communities. The community is being continuously educated by the medium of regular meetings in which they are educated about the importance of the natural resources which we use in our daily lives. The community is being aware on the hazardous effects on environment due to mining activities in the various locations of the project area. The minimize the effects of deforestation there, has been continuous efforts for Plantation on claimed Community Forest lands, individual lands, in the school campus, besides road side area and in the village boundary

along with empty lands and in forest area also. Seed collection is also done on a large scale and it is being exchanged. Food festivals are organized to raise awareness among community for understanding of nutritional values in the community. The community is also being aware by the medium of exposure visit to the locations where Community Forest Rights have been awarded and how they are skilled in the management of the forest. By the medium of the above mentioned activities the organization is trying to connect the communities to the social inclusion.

Theme-Sustainable Tribal Livelihood.

Another Project STL- Sustainable Tribal Livelihood is being implemented in the Gariyaband district. The organization is providing livelihood opportunity to the beneficiaries from the 21 villages of Gariyaband block. In which the community is being provided with the opportunity for Goatry, Puoltry and Fishery. Along with that the organization provided seed support to 125 beneficiaries for paddy cultivation, 125 for Mixed Crop Farming and 200 female beneficiaries for Kitchen Garden every year for promoting organic farming with indigenous seeds. The basic concept for the Kitchen Gardening is to ensure availability of vegetables in their daily routine which provides continuous nutritional values in their daily consumption. Thus the total number of beneficiaries are supported every year is around 500 beneficiaries. Apart from that the organization believes in the capacity building for the beneficiaries through various training programs, Capacity building programs, and Awareness programs for sustainable development of the community. The training programs are based of ecological farming, trainings on Goatry, Fishery and Poultry, Seed bank management, Adoption planning on Climate change are the focus area for the community to be self reliant.

Theme- Old Age Home

The noble initiative conducted by the organization is Siyan Seva Sadan (Old age Home) which is being run in Bhilai of Gariyaband district. The old age home facilitates to the 25 old age people who are helpless and hapless. It is our moral responsibility to look after to the older persons who have no source of income now and who have been left by their own families. The Old age home is having facilities with fooding and staying, medical services, Health Facilities and counseling and proper attention is given to the individuals.

| | | Theme- Using Diversity This program of Using Diversity is being implemented in Gariaband and Korba district of Chhattisgarh over 10 villages of Pali Block in Korba district and 10 villages of Mainpur Block in Gariaband district. The main purpose of this program is to strengthen the forest dwellers (mainly PVTGs) through promotion of forest foods, mix-cropping and ecological agriculture and developing kitchen garden at household level, awareness activities are conducted to people on their rights and various government |

The village level meetings are conducted and information is collected about various forest foods, their livelihood patterns, problems and various issues faced by them in their villages. The organization is also working on community forest rights and individual forest rights and habitat rights. Apart from this, project fellows visit different places to collect traditional seeds. Traditional uncultivated foods are decreasing in the forest village area due to deforestation, mining and other reasons. These wild foods are good supplement for their daily food consumption. Also, some people earn additional income by selling these wild foods in the local market. So, efforts are being made to motivate the community people for conservation of these uncultivated foods. |
